Annual boating passes are issued beginning on July 1st of each year and are valid through June 30th of the following year. Boat passes are required to access the Maitland Winter Park chain-of-lakes at either of 2 boating ramps:

Fort Maitland - 900 Orlando Avenue - Maitland Dinky Dock - 410 Ollie Avenue - Winter Park

Rates for Maitland Residents = Length of Boat + Horsepower of Boat x \$.50 (no tax)

Rates for Non-Residents = Length of Boat + Horsepower of Boat x \$.75 (no tax)


